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2022 ALEXANA 'ESTATE VINEYARD' PINOT NOIR

DUNDEE HILLS - WILLAMETTE VALLEY

This wine expresses our entire Estate's dramatically diverse terroir, which includes 18 out of 26 different soil types in Oregon. This unique expression of Oregon Pinot Noir comes from one of the Willamette Valley's most respected vineyards and contains La Tâche, Pommard, Wädenswil, Mount Eden, Coury, 113, 114, 115, 667, 777, 828, and 943.

11 months in French Oak Barrels (35% New, 28% Once-Filled, 37% Neutral)

TASTING NOTES

NOSE | wet soil and clay, red cherry and raspberries, baking spices, sandalwood, mossy, rose petals

PALATE | plush, broad across the palate, potpourri and berry, long spine, lingers on

2022 ALEXANA 'FENNWOOD VINEYARD' PINOT NOIR

YAMHILL-CARLTON - WILLAMETTE VALLEY

Planted under the guidance of Oregon pioneer David Adelsheim, this vineyard sits on a low ridge line comprised of volcanic soils. A personality unique within the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, this site is known for its intensely perfumed high toned red fruits and earthy elegance. Only nine barrels were produced in the 2022 vintage from 3 blocks consisting of the Pommard, Wädenswil, and 777 clones.

11 months in French Oak Barrels (22% New French Oak, 22% Once Filled French Oak, 56% Neutral French Oak)

TASTING NOTES

NOSE | berry compote, graham cracker, wet soil, anise, jasmine and honeysuckle

PALATE | deeply layered and powerful, leather and tobacco, incredible presencecompote, with soft tannins

2022 ALEXANA 'ZENA CROWN VINEYARD' PINOT NOIR

EOLA-AMITY HILLS - WILLAMETTE VALLEY

Widely considered a Grand Cru site within the Willamette Valley, the Zena Crown Vineyard sits on a south-facing slope at the center of the Eola-Amity Hills AVA. The unique position of this vineyard is impacted greatly by the Pacific Ocean breezes coming through the Van Duzer Corridor. The personality of Pinot Noir clones 777 and 828 from this site presents a powerful structure, vibrancy, and a depth of dark fruit rarely found in Oregon.

11 months in French Oak Barrels (15% New French Oak, 33% Once Filled French Oak, 52% Neutral French Oak)

TASTING NOTES

NOSE | blood orange, white pepper, licorice, cocoa powder, blueberry, graham cracker

PALATE | velvety texture, spicy and red, incredibly long lingering finish, balsam
